Sub Committee Reports:

Junior Golf:

Two junior members have applied for Intermediate membership. G.Hill advised that they had been granted permission to play in Sunday Competitions in the interim and a review at the beginning of the next playing season would decide whether they could move into playing Saturday golf. It was felt that proceeding in this manner would be in their best interest.

Match & Pennant Report.

Teams have reported to B.Cutler their preference for Club support during next Pennant season. It was agreed that club would enter in the Junior, Intermediate, Championship and Handicap Pennants grades next season.

G.Hill has applied for Grant from the Grassroots Trust to assist with expenses next season. Every effort will be made to ensure teams are supported as much as finances will allow.

G.Hill is awaiting ruling from B O P Golf regarding eligibility of 9 Hole members for Pennant season.

Vet President asked if there was any possibility of a vet's Pennant series being established along the lines of the Waikato Golf Vet Pennant series.

General Business

Reported that Vet's five day Tournament had seventy-six confirmed entries and expected more late entries before cut of date. Numbers should be comparable to previous year's Tournaments.

Application to Lion Foundation for funding assisting next season had been unsuccessful.

Board is still reviewing Vision 20 draft and will complete review within the next few weeks.

Election for board members was not required so board make up remains the same as last year.

Nominations for men's committee are open and election will take place at men's committee A.G.M to be held on the second weekend of November. J.Prescott informed the meeting that he would not be standing for committee at the A.G.M.

It was pointed out that all men members are eligible to stand for men's committee and it was not just Saturday golfers who could stand for this committee. There appeared to have been some confusion about this with some members in past years.

Club membership had declined by around 60 members and CEO noted that there was no consistent pattern to reasons for resignations.

Green staff were to be congratulated on presentation of both courses and in particular the Centennial Course.

P.E.Gangs had not been available in recent weeks but would still be utilized when available to work on course.

Middlemore Mugs prizes would be confirmed with Wellington & Auckland Golf Associations and CEO was trying to obtain some green fee concessions to be used for club prizes during next season from both associations.
