Junior Golf:

There has been a request to join Saturday Competition by one junior member.

Match & Pennant Report.

Moved B.Cutler seconded G.Price that the finalists in the Tappenden Trophy be allowed to play final before due date if all agreed. This motion was voted on by committee and passed in favour.

J.Prescott & B.Cutler to arrange meeting with Pennant Team managers to

discuss next year's Pennant series.

G.Hill to ask B.O.P.Golf whether 9 Hole members are eligible for Pennant Teams.

General Business

Discussion with J.Morgan took place to determine Committee Duty Person's responsibilities for Saturday Golf.

Committee to investigate providing a course marshal for Saturday golf.

Shootout has been poorly supported this year but will still be held but only on Centennial Course.

M.Munro brought committee up to speed with upcoming 5 day Vet's Tournament.

Vet's have applied to Lion Foundation for funding of \$4000.

Expressed concern regarding some of the proposed changes suggested for Tuahara course outlined in the draft 20/20 Course Vision Document.

G.Price presented results of player survey for future Saturday Golf playing program. Committee to study results of the survey and the proposed program for next year then make their recommendations at next meeting.

Moved J. Davis seconded J.Howell that the Vet golfers & 9 Hole golfers be invited to have a representative on the men's committee, with no voting rights, to keep men's committee up to date with their respective activities.

This should help to keep everyone abreast of committee decisions and activities and eliminate lack of communication between groups.

A remit to AGM will be made covering this motion.

A vigorous discussion was conducted amongst committee members in

relation to the 20/20 Course Vision Draft. G.Hill took on board member's concerns and suggestions, emphasizing that this was a draft document and not the final 20/20 Course Vision Statement. It is envisaged that the final document will be a work in progress that will assist in the future financial decisions necessary for work to be carried out on both courses.

Discussion on Saturday Golf having handicap divisions to enable a spread of results across the handicap range will be investigated as part of next year's Saturday Golf program. Participants in Saturday golf will also be encouraged to make a commitment to play in all rounds of any tournament they have entered.
