9 Hole Report:

Vets Report:

3 member played at Te Aroha after qualifying for the event.

Saturday Report:

Sub Committees:

2. Handicapping - all under control.
3. Social - "Hot August Night" to be held Saturday 14th August, tickets \$35 per head. DJ had been organised, Sue and Sharon had discussed with Darryl a suitable menu for the occasion.

General Business:
