

MINUTES OF MEN'S PLAYERS COMMITTEE MEETING

Sub Committee Reports

Match Committee:- Reported they had resolved that handicap as of 7th August would determine division in both strokeplay and matchplay champs.

Disciplinary Committee:- This committee had met regarding a junior member's ripped up, incomplete scorecard handed in to the office. Resolved to speak to the two members concerned pointing out that all scorecards should be returned, including practice rounds which should bear a notation to that effect. Junior Development:- Bryce reported that organized coaching seminars for junior players had not been well attended. He expressed his disappointment with the response and suggested further efforts be put on hold at this time.

Course Upgrade:- Grant outlined the work planned for the immediate future noting that the leveling of tees had started. He asked for comment regarding further distance signage on the tees. There was discussion regarding pin placement on Centennial No.2 although this may have been driven by the chairman's frustration earlier in the day.

General Business

1. Tauhara Shoot-out:- Preliminary preparation were put in place. Resolved not to hold a Calcutta for this event.
2. Joint Men's / Women's Committee initiative in becoming more involved in club running Club open events. Grant suggested it was time for action on this and the chairman agreed to contact the Woman's captain re forming a joint committee for this purpose.
3. Composite Course Event:- Grant had seen this operating in Australia where a round comprised of 9 holes on each course. Felt there could be a place for such an event at Taupo. The committee were in favour of this concept begin further developed but did wonder if he was being serious in suggesting it be named the Intercourse Championship and the chairman saw fit to close the meeting at this point.
