Matters Arising from the Minutes:

18th Tee Path: Concern that this is still being used and in an unsatisfactory condition. Grant to ask Greens Staff about closing it off if it can't be upgraded.

Qualifying Trophies: Decided not to play any fixtures that had only a money prize (no trophy).

Ecclectics: This to be one prize only and to be: Club Scores only for both Tuesday and Saturday ladies, and only on Tauhara. Scores will be entered on computer, so there will be no need for manual entries on to cards. To begin Tuesday 7th April. Grant to arrange competition set up in computer.

9 Hole: 9 Hole Championship: Val confirmed that there was a cup for this event. 9 Hole ladies going well with up to 40 playing each Monday. Some concern about the placement of some extra day players playing with the field, as so huge. It was decided that extra day players should play at the back of the field.
Hospice Tournament: To be held on 4th or 5th May. Prizes usually donated. Ladies Committee to held with organisation and on the day.

Club Shirts: Michelle taking last orders this week, and won't be ordering further for a few months and has put up a notice to this effect.

General Business:

Shootout: Dorothy Stone has handed over the organisation of this event to the committee. Jenny Ewart agreed to take charge of the money. Qualifiers to be e-mailed and list will go on to the noticeboard. This will replace the old system of advising players by letter. Entries to the office, and the entry fee is \$15. Date for Shootout to start is 26th May.

It was suggested that we could look at running a two day tournament - 18 holes stableford, and second day 18 holes foursomes. Jenny, Mary and Sue as a sub-committee to look at and bring to next meeting.

Matchplay: Viv to confirm her e-mail from Bay of Plenty Golf to determine whether or not cards are to be put in for matchplay.

Meetings: To be held on the last Tuesday of each month.

Locker Room: Denise to get costing of converting the ladies locker room to a trundler storage area with a swipe card lock up system. This could be a "wish list" item re funding the change.
