MATTERS ARISING/GENERAL BUSINESS

Chris Player

Saturday Ladies – Chris Gillett advises nothing to report to meeting.

Shift player definition – Chris sought clarification on this. It was agreed a player needs to simply ensure they do not play in both comps of the week. Shootout OK as has separate entry fee.

Taumarunui Interclub – Taumarunui Club day is Wednesday and several dates have been suggested. It was thought appropriate to establish if the Club holds any Xmas tournaments or similar events which we could attend, particularly avoiding mid-winter.

Action: Chris to make contact and report back.

Annie Whyte tournament – around 10 names on list to date.

Centennial 16th bank – has received feedback from members that this is dangerous with several members falling. Grant advised that this has already been addressed by management and a path will be constructed in the next few weeks.

Tee markers – raised concern that the yellow tee's appear to be put back further than acceptable and on occasions appear to have more back than forward, or combined back tee with a pin at back of green. **Action:** Grant to raise with Grant Wilson to establish what his plan is and how it complies with NZ Golf guidelines.

Locker room – advised that an apology was made by the board for not applying for funds for the upgrade.

Raffle – the change to roster seems to be working well with Sue reminding players of their rostered week. Some players are donating the prize and therefore fund should build quickly.

Club day Aug 15th – reminded committee that this is day for the major raffle – all players to bring a prize. Chris will remind players closer to the time.

Handicap strokes – received query on how many strokes should be given on Tauhara between yellow and white tees as on Sunday 3 were given. Grant advised that this was his error as should have been 4 shots, with 3 provided on Centennial.

Juniors – over 60 kids attending and going well.

First Aid – suggested we could hold some basic First Aid training before or after golf. **Action:** Grant to investigate options and costs.

Pennant shirts – thought the women's shirts could be improved and also women's sizes purchased. There was a discussion over whether the club should provide shirts for pennants or if the club should make available for sale an official shirt like we already do with jersey. **Action:** Viv to meet with Proshop to see what options are available and report back.

Marian Lourie

Convenor – Leone Robertson was previously “convenor” and 9 Hole Captain. Has received a suggestion that 9 Hole should have a separate convenor. Chris and Ali thought that the 9 Hole committee lead by Marian has it under control and if they needed help

could call on main committee of golf manager.

Stableford system – sought some help for new players on how to score stableford. Grant suggested he was happy to do this on a regular basis if required along with his occasional tips provided.

Champagne breakfast held 2 weeks which went well. Have an interclub event at Springfield in 2 weeks time.

Nearest the pin – had received a query if ball needed to be on the green to be eligible as sometimes a ball off the green can be closer, or no player gets on the green. Chris suggested that this was the rule in most clubs and that if prize not won on course would be used as lucky draw.

Grant Hill

2007 Programme – has commenced work on this and has scheduled course usage based on normal annual programme to ensure course is allocated for club golf prior to any bookings being received. Will forward programme to committee in due course for any changes.

Starting tee's – has produced a matrix of what tees to use based on course/player number for Monday, Tuesday and Thursday competitions. Would like feedback if any issues using this as has been designed to utilise closest tees but also manage course for casual play.

Foursomes 27 Hole – entry forms ready to post out. Sponsors confirmed as Morris Catering and Anchor Milk. Committee agreed same format as last year.

Liquor King Mixed Foursomes – sought any feedback on format for this event as will be getting entry forms printed shortly. No changes suggested.

Player of the Year – currently backdating points into a spreadsheet with leaderboard to be posted in locker room.
