Soft Spikes – letter received by the Board from Liz regarding safety of soft spikes following an accident attributed to the spikes after slipping near 5th toilets. Grant advised Course Manager was looking at options to improve tread and had already increased the number of shoe cleaners to allow spikes to be cleaned regularly during round.

Handicap Report – Nil

Ali Flavell – has indicated she will not be standing for committee next year due to work commitments. Chris suggested that existing committee seek expressions of interest from members.

27 Hole tournament – Grant sought feedback on this event which was held while he was away. Feedback was positive with only issue raised the multi-tee starting for afternoon round caused confusion and also meant a fair bit of walking to/from tee. Grant stated this was done as the previous year people complained of the wait to get on 1st or 10th starting tees. The draw was also done to ensure players who started close to clubhouse in morning round did not for afternoon round. **Action:** Grant will look at alternative options which may include same format with better instructions.
