New business:

- a) Rotorua Interclub on Thursday 15th October. *Grant to action email reminders and Viv will do telephone promotion.*
- b) 9 Hole Report:

Turangi Interclub on Tuesday 6th October could encourage a regular exchange. Some complaints about 9am start time. (No change).

9 Hole Men joining 9 Hole Women on Monday 5th October.
