Funds to date have been raised from raffles (), Club contribution \$800, Viv Nyssen has donated her hole in one \$100 to the fund. **Action:** Sue to approach other upholsterers (Jeff Mayhill) for alternative quote and possible contra for membership. Mary to seek quote for painting. Carolyn to approach Bruce regarding funding application and any further funds in budget.
