Over 70's trophy – there was a suggestion that a change to Over 55's may be appropriate. Anne advised the trophy was provided specifically for over 70's and therefore thought appropriate to remain as such.

Vet Champs – confirmed that this was open to only those who were financial members of the Vets (\$5 sub).

Sue Jolly

Funding for locker room – expressed disappointment that a grant application was submitted. Assumes the Club has had to cover the cost and a grant application can not be made retrospectively.

Raffle – suggested raffle's could be run for specific purpose. After discussion, "Save the Sofa Raffle" was agreed to get locker room sofa recovered. **Action:** Grant to do Poster.

Grant Hill

Distance Measuring devices – proposal from Proshop to rent GPS units which provide distances. As they are effectively a Course Guide and not expected to slow play, Grant was happy to recommend their approval. The R&A requires a local rule to be implemented to allow them to be used. Men's committee agreed to it with a review in 6 months, Women's committee agreed to same. **Action:** Grant to post local rule covering

their use.

Starting tee usage – following last meeting Grant offered the option of using additional tees on Centennial which would be 1,7,9,10,11 and could cope with up to 72 players. Some thought some tees would be too far away as would require players to walk further.
Action: Grant to draw up a matrix of which tees to use for various numbers and will trial.
