Business arising from previous minutes:

New Tuesday format playing in groups of 3 will speed up field by approximately 30 minutes.

Q & A with Gordan Ward:

#17 Centennial Tee too far back for some members and dangerous if ball lands half way up hill - due to budget constraints and not wanting to adjust the length of the hole, on club days Silver and Bronze I will use yellow tees and Bronze II will use terracotta tees.

#3 Centennial Tee will be repaired.

#15 Tauhara tap leaking

Twin Classics Tournament 24th and 25th February request easier pin placements.

Rakes should be placed outside of bunker on the rough side as per the NZ golf ruling.

Suggestion that different coloured flags could be used to indicate position of hole: budget and time constraints limit this.

#6 Tauhara needs sign showing location of 7th Tee (will put on wish list)

Suggestion that signs could be erected to indicate how long play should take to certain points to help move the field along. (Will put on wish list)

Pumice areas adjacent to tees will be cobbled on Tauhara.

Tauhara 10th and 13th area will have a covered/paved area on the right hand side to encourage people to wait there to tee off in safety.

Watering costs \$300-\$400 per night.

#4 Centennial trees will be removed along the perimeter for a Contact Energy service lane.

Bunkers are raked on Wednesday's and Friday's due to the heavy usage on these days.

New holes are cut on Tuesday's.

Collars are used to keep the shape of the hole as they tend to cave in with the foot traffic over the week.
