MATTERS ARISING/GENERAL BUSINESS

Opening Day format was discussed with the following decisions.

Vets - Anne Taylor

Opening day on 9th February.

Because it is so early **Bruce** to organise a notice for the paper advising **Opening Day** for Vet ladies. The competition will be foursomes.

Saturday ladies - Chris Gillett

Opening day on 18th February.

Chris put forward suggestions as follows.

◆ Ecelectics. Would like Saturday players to have separate ecelectic cards.
