**MATTERS ARISING**

## **GENERAL BUSINESS**

### **Chris Player**

**Shootout** – Bayview Wairakei Resort has agreed to sponsor the Tuesday Shootout for 2006 and provide 19 prizes ranging from restaurant vouchers to golf equipment. As an entry fee is paid Chris suggested prizes could be supplemented by petrol vouchers or similar. Grant suggested an option to provide funds to sponsor to boost their prizes. It was agreed that after paying for BBQ & mulled wine, the balance of fund would be offered to Wairakei Resort to increase prize value. **Action: Chris** to confirm sponsorship and offer increase in prize fund. **Grant** to source logo to include on leaderboard.

**Saturday's** – Chris Gillett wished to query the stroke indexes and when they are likely to be updated. Grant advised that the Course manager was currently preparing plan for new tee signage which would be catalyst for update of stroke index's but if this was further than a couple of months away changes to existing signs would be made.

**Matches** – current policy is if match is not played by due date, the “bottom” person on draw goes through. This seemed unfair as can advantage player who is difficult to arrange matches with. Grant advised the Men disqualify both players. After discussion it was decided to continue with status quo for season but review for next season.

**27 Hole Foursomes** – Grant has preparation work completed and has employed Linda Cooper to manage the day in his absence with the help of Bruce and Natalie. Entries going strong and full field of 120 players looks likely. Lyn & Viv have prize purchasing under control. **Action: Chris** to ask Judy Nairn about Xmas Tree. **Grant** to arrange Hampers for raffle. Morning tea – it was decided to contract Daryl & Karen to provide, **Grant** to arrange.

**Aug 15<sup>th</sup> club day** – mulled wine to be provided and is the day for major “save the sofa” raffle where members bring a prize. **Action: Chris** to ask Dorothy Stone to help with mulled wine and remind members of raffle day.

**Nearest the pins** – suggestion to have two bronze and two Silver each week rather than currently open to all. Agreed.

### **Bev McCauley**

**Starting** – has requested that groups of 3 be off first on tee's 1 & 15. **Action: Grant** to add to starting matrix.

## **Sue Jolly**

**Gobler** – has suggested a “Gobler” trophy for “chip ins” which can be recorded by players on club days. All agreed this was a good idea and should be included in next years programme. An appropriate sponsor to be sought.

**Green Fee in tournaments** – advised some tournaments have a reduced entry fee for Members effectively charging a partial green fee to visitors and this could be a way of increasing benefit to club from tournaments. **Action: Grant** to survey BOP Clubs.

**Ladies 9 Hole Club day** - due to wet weather and public holidays have had limited club days last few weeks. A casual 9 Hole Ambrose is being played Thursdays at 1.30pm on Tauhara which is proving popular. Open tournament planning underway for Sept 4<sup>th</sup>.

**Vouchers** – Grant sought feedback on how much value is placed on club vouchers being provided for Club days at club expense and is having a weekly entry fee appropriate. Received a mixed reaction and as a result Grant will establish what other Bop clubs are doing.

**Matchplay** – queried if any protocol for matches receiving priority over casual or club play. All agreed that there was no protocol and players in matches are to comply with course availability or report to club day starter.
